BANCA POPOLARE DI SONDRIO CAPITAL RATIOS ARE WELL ABOVE THE NEW EUROPEAN CENTRAL BANK'S REQUIREMENTS

Banca Popolare di Sondrio informs that it received from the European Central Bank (ECB) the notification of the new decision concerning prudential requirements to be met on a consolidated basis, following the conclusion of the Supervisory Review and Evaluation Process (SREP) conducted during 2016.

The minimum *Common Equity Tier 1 ratio* (CET1 ratio) has been set at 7.25%, calculated as the sum of the minimum Pillar 1 requirement equal to 4.50%, an additional Pillar 2 requirement equal to 1.50% and the Capital Conservation Buffer equal to 1.25%.

The minimum *Total capital ratio* has been set at 10.75%, calculated as sum of the minimum Pillar 1 requirement equal to 8%, an additional Pillar 2 requirement equal to 1.50% and the Capital Conservation Buffer equal to 1.25%.

As of 30th September 2016 the prudential ratios are largely above the requirements, being:

- 11.22% phase in CET 1 ratio;
- 13.83% phase in Total Capital ratio.
